The Dean's Graduate Research Fund was established to encourage and support graduate students conducting research to address complex, critical issues facing society. Thematic priorities will vary from year-to-year.

#### 2020-21 RESEARCH PRIORITY

For the 2020-21 academic year, the Dean's Graduate Research Fund will provide funding for research expenses to support graduate student research activities related to issues of systemic and structural racism, decolonization, reconciliation, critical race theory, and the impact of policies and social processes on marginalized communities. This fund is open to research from any disciplinary, theoretical, and/or methodological perspective exploring these issues.

Examples of potential expenses that a student might expect to incur related to their research are as follows: incentives for participants; materials and supplies; accommodation costs for participants (e.g. travel, interpreters, etc.); costs associated with childcare; and/or to cover costs of registration for, and travel to, scholarly conferences associated with the dissemination of research or other knowledge mobilization activities.

All applications are to be submitted via e-mail to csahsadr@uoguelph.ca by March 5, 2021.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Clarity of project description and its outcomes;
- Alignment with the thematic priority;
- Appropriateness of methodology, if required;
- Scholarly significance and potential impact; and
- The project's feasibility within the projected timeline and budget.

#### **Terms of Funding**

Successful applicants will attest to the following as part of the application process:

Upon completion of the project, recipients will submit a brief, but detailed summary of the work supported (max. one page) to the Dean, College of Social and Applied Human Sciences (csahsadr@uoguelph.ca)

Recognition of this funding source, when appropriate, will be acknowledged in the dissemination of material resulting from this project.
