Graduate Excellence Scholarships are awarded to entering graduate students who demonstrate outstanding academic performance and/or potential and leadership potential, either through their past achievements, or through their proposed research program and career aspirations.

For 2021-22, scholarships will be reserved for Canadian or permanent residents that self-identify as Black and/or Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit, and Métis).

Application Process

Eligible applicants are required to submit a complete application form and one letter of support* (max. one page) from a reference who can speak to the applicant's leadership potential, experience, and qualities. Applications must include a statement of declaration identifying one's self as Black and/or Indigenous. Completed applications and letters of support are to be submitted to the applicant's home department.

Deadlines may vary by department.

*Departmental Awards committees with review academic reference letters submitted as part of students' application packages. Students may submit an alternative letter of support should they choose.

Value and Duration

Recipients will receive a one-time award. Award is stackable.

Award amounts may vary.

Adjudication and Selection

Eligible applications will be reviewed and selected by the awards committee in the department to which they will be applying.

Notice, Consent, and Declaration

Personal information provided on the Graduate Excellence Scholarship application form, and required supporting documentation, will be collected by the University of Guelph to administer the scholarship.
