You can also easily access data trends to see how well your students are doing. Cengage Mindtap is another great integrated tool through a paid membership. It gives professors the opportunity to customize their learning delivery and add notes directly into the text and professors can also keep track of students progress with automatic grading of quizzes and participation.

Kahoot is another popular integrated tool. It is a free resource that students can access from any personal device to encourage participation in quizzes or in surveys.
